We encourage visitors to use public transport, cycling or walking routes wherever possible, in preference to car travel.

Pedestrian access

Pedestrians can enter from the A40 entrance and are requested to use the footpath adjacent to Thomas White Street.

Alternatively there is an accessible footpath connecting the A40 and A44 that leads through Fallaize Park.

Vehicle access

Access is via Gate 1, A40/Witney Road.

Security personnel will be present to greet you.

Accessibility

There is level access and an accessible WC for mobility impaired persons and wheelchair users.

By bike

There are safe cycle store facilities available.

The footpath connecting A40 and A44 is a green route and accepts bikes.

By bus

We are well-connected with bus routes on both the A40 and A44 with the following services:

A40

Stagecoach S1 - Carterton to Oxford.

Stagecoach S2 - Witney to Oxford.

Stagecoach H2 - Witney to John Radcliffe Hospital.

A44

Stagecoach S3 - Chipping North/Charlbury to City to Oxford Station.

Park & Ride 300 - Peartree Park & Ride to City to Redbridge Park & Ride.

By train

Oxford Parkway is the closest station. Oxford and Oxford Parkway stations both provide connections to London, Bicester and the wider rail network.

By taxi

Taxis are available from the City Centre and from both Oxford train stations. These can be ordered from Royal Cars or via Uber, which also operates in the area.

By car

From the City Centre, take the Woodstock Road to Wolvercote roundabout, go west on the A40 and turn right at the traffic lights into Thomas White Street.

From Witney, go under the A34 onto the A40 and turn left into Thomas White Street.

You will be directed to park in the on-site car park, marked on the map.
